University of Michigan

The middle 50% of the class had:
Unweighted high school GPA of 3.7–4.0
28% had a 4.0 GPA
53% had a 3.9 or higher GPA [academic courses only grades 10 & 11]
ACT Composite of 27–31
SAT 1 Total 1900–2180

Michigan State University

The middle 50% of the class had:
High School GPA of 3.4–3.8 [academic courses only grades 9, 10 & 11]
ACT Composite of 22–27
SAT 1 Total 1040–1270

Western Michigan University

Mid 50% had a GPA of 3.0–3.49
Mid 50% had an ACT score of 20–25

University of Wisconsin

76% of applicants had a 3.5 GPA or higher
ACT score of 26–30

Eastern Michigan University

33% had a 3.0–3.49 GPA and 45% had a 2.0–2.49 GPA
ACT composite, the mid 50% had a 18–24

Grand Valley State University

GPA of 3.3–3.8
ACT score of 22–26

Northwestern University
